### **The Secrets of 2012 and the Mayan Prophecies – Rev. A. Win Srogi**

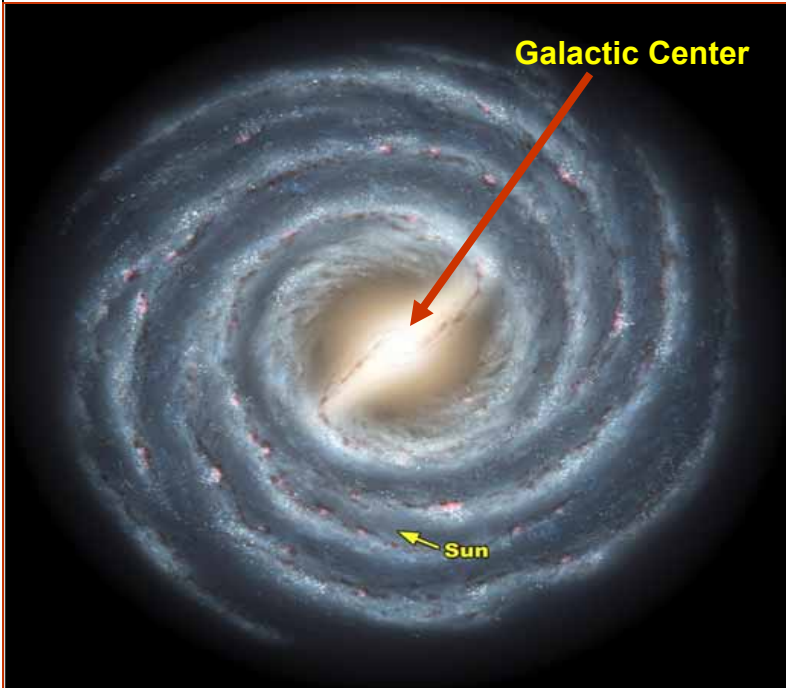
During the past several years we have seen many books and even TV shows covering what some call the end date of December 21, 2012, according to the Mayan Calendar. Some Christian groups are going so far as to call this date the “End of Days” and are building a Christian Theme Park on the Mediterranean Sea, so they can have some fun prior to their pilgrimage to Jerusalem on December 21, 2012.

What does the Mayan Prophecy really say and what is the significance of the 2012 Winter Solstice, December 21, 2012 or 13.0.0.0.0 in the Mayan dating system? The Mayan’s were astronomical observers and very advanced with their binary number system, even using the zero, prior to 200 A.D., when the Mayan began building their astronomical-ceremonial stone centers. There is little evidence of formative stages or trial and error to develop their system of hieroglyphics and mathematics; it is a complete system of notations, mathematics, and astronomical calculations with a highly developed hieroglyphic code. And yet to this day many archeologists continue to refer to them as primitive.

So, who were the Mayan, where did they come from and why were they here? Many theories exist from space travelers from another system, descendants from Atlantis, to spiritually developed messengers providing us with a “spiritual roadmap” of times to come. Without question their focus was Galactic in nature with a focus on the Milky Way galaxy of which our solar system is a part and the Galactic Center of this galaxy in specific (as shown on the next page).

Through their knowledge and observations they developed the Sacred Calendar or Tzolkin, a 260 day calendar composed of 13 numbers and 20 symbols. When laid out in a grid pattern with 13 columns for the numbers and 20 rows for the symbols you begin to see the matrix pattern which served not only as a method to keep track of the cycles of planet earth but also with what they considered to be a master cycle within our solar system and galaxy. Their view of our solar system was that it was a living organism and that our Sun and Planets were living beings. Anyone who has studied A. A. Bailey and the works of the Tibetan should recognize this statement as being one and the same with the teachings of the Tibetan. Planet Earth is a living being whom many call Gaia.

The Mayan teachings tell us that evolution and spiritual advancement is dependent on the electromagnetic pulses or waves emitted from the Galactic Center. These waves are transmitted to our solar system via the Sun and then out to the various planets. The intensity of these waves is dependent on the alignment of our solar system with the Galactic Center and directly tied to the precession cycle of 25,627 years which is equal to five times 13 baktun cycles of 5125.36 years. A period of 13 baktuns is considered by the Maya to be one world age.



The Mayan date of December 21, 2012, is based on the alignment of the Solstice Sun with the Galactic Center. In astronomical terms, it is the alignment of the solstice meridian with the galactic equator. According to the U. S. Naval Observatory calculations the actual date of this alignment was October 27, 1998. We must also consider the fact that due to the size of the Sun it takes 36 years to pass through the Galactic Center. Using 1998 as the midpoint, our contact with the Galactic Center began in 1980 and continues through 2016. Just look at what is happening in the world today and you will see we are in the midst of change.

From this information we can see that this is a process not a single day event. And it is not just the Mayan's who predicted world cycles and changes. The Vedic doctrine of World Ages, conservatively dating back to 7000 B. C., uses a precessional period of 24,000 years. At the present time we are at the midpoint of the Kali Yuga period where the human spirit suffers under gross materialism, ignorance, warfare, stupidity, arrogance and everything contrary to our divine potential. The good point about being at the midpoint is that the downward decent reverses and we begin our ascent into a more spiritual consciousness. This is a confirmation of the Mayan prophecies for this time in the history of man.

This prophecy is also confirmed by the Hopi Indians on their prophecy rock. This rock contains a picture of two paths which man can walk. The upper path leads to abandonment of mother earth, shows man's head disconnected from his body and leads to utter lack. The lower path shows man walking in harmony with mother earth and leads to an abundance of corn. There is also a third path, a vertical path, showing that man can make a conscious choice at this time and choose which path to walk.

According to the Mayan Prophecy the alignment with the Galactic Center will provide an influx of electromagnetic wave energy providing mankind the opportunity to align with the energy of the universe. The prophecy also indicates that mankind's thoughts or consciousness play a very important role in the outcome. The question now is – **Will mankind as a whole reach the necessary critical mass of group consciousness to effect the coming change in a positive way or not?** (Please watch our schedule for the Mayan Workshop planned for this summer and learn much more about this information.)
