## **SEMINARY GUIDELINES**

All students and faculty are required to attend the Chapel 6:30 p.m. Student Worship Service during the weeklong seminars. Students who anticipate serving in the Chapel 6:00 p.m. Healing Service or Worship Service should bring suitable clothing: suit and tie for men and long dress or skirt for women. All students working toward Certification are expected to participate in the 6:30 p.m. Student Services in order to demonstrate proficiency in all aspects of a service: Chairperson, Speaker, and Message Bearer.

See a Student Advisor in the Administration Office to familiarize yourself with week-long seminars and other classes and services necessary for Certification or Ordination.

Students are required to attend every day of each class, in order to receive credit for that class. Please be sure to bring comfortable clothing and shoes to wear to class and in accordance with the weather conditions. During the summer months no shorts, halters, mini-skirts or mini-dresses are allowed in the classrooms or the Chapel. There will be some walking between buildings. Consider bringing an umbrella, pens, notebooks, and Bible. Supplies for Psychic Art are listed in the Academic Resource Center Book with the class description. Canadians should contact the Administration Office for information regarding Canadian funds.

You are required to include a 50% deposit to hold your room for seminar. Deposits will not be refunded if cancellation is not made 7 days prior to first day of registration. No food is permitted in the hotel rooms.
